2025-26 Scholarship Fund Program

Guidelines

The United Hmong Education Foundation (UHEF) is dedicated to helping Hmong youth to attend and succeed in the educational arena. The belief that “every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources” is echoed throughout the Foundation’s work. United Hmong Education Foundation facilitates partnerships with key stakeholders to increase academic achievement of youth.

The **Mission** of United Hmong Education Foundation is to BUILD a collaborative network of diverse stakeholders to IMPROVE the quality of education in the targeted communities.

The **Vision** of United Hmong Education Foundation is empowering the youth in the designated area with need-based educational resources.

The **Purpose** of the **UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund** and **UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund** is to provide scholarships to deserving high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study full-time at either a two-year or four-year educational institution.

For the upcoming school year starting from Fall 2025 to Summer 2026, UHEF is proud to offer the UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj and UHEF FUTURE scholarships.

The UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund’s award ceiling is \$2,000. UHEF will award scholarships, ranging in amounts from \$500 - \$2,000 per award, based on applicant’s college/university choice, application needs, and how many applicants. **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution and class schedule submitted for fund disbursement. Scholarship funds will be distributed at the beginning of each school Semester, with 50% of funds for each disbursement.**

Criteria and eligibility (UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund applicants)

1. Applicant must be a Hmong descent.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant must reside in the United States.
4. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a “C” average).
5. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
6. Applicant must be enrolled and attend full time in a two-year or four-year educational institution.
7. Applicant may not be child of any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

For the UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund, UHEF will award scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 - \$3,000 per award. For returning scholarship recipients, scholarships may be renewed if the recipient has met renewal criteria. The total number of renewals will be determined by the UHEF Scholarship Committee.

Criteria and eligibility (UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund applicants)

1. Applicant must be a Hmong descent.

2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant must reside in the United States.
4. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a “C” average).
5. Applicant must have a desired college major in Science, Technology, or Engineering.
6. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
7. Applicant must be enrolled and attend full time in a two-year or four-year educational institution.
8. Applicant may not be child of any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

Criteria and eligibility (returning recipients)

1. Applicant must be a recipient of the UHEF Scholarship Fund Program.
2. Applicant must be currently enrolled full time in a two-year or four-year educational institution.
3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a “C” average).
4. Applicant may not be child of any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

General Instructions

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications must be postmarked by mail or sent and received from email by **April 30, 2025, 11:59 p.m. PST** (no exceptions).
2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
4. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at <https://www.theuhef.org/>.
5. If selected, you will be notified of scholarship award by end of June.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant’s experience and involvement.
4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
5. Personal Essay. **What are your educational and professional goals and objectives?** Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font.

Returning Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of yourself and continued college and life plans. Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of college instructors, advisors, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant’s experience and involvement.
4. An official and recent college transcript with cumulative grade point average.
5. Personal Essay. **How has attending college impacted your life?** Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font. Essay shall contain no grammatical errors.
6. In addition to the above items, applicant must also complete at least 20 hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter.

Deadline for the application is **April 30, 2025, 11:59 p.m. PST**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.

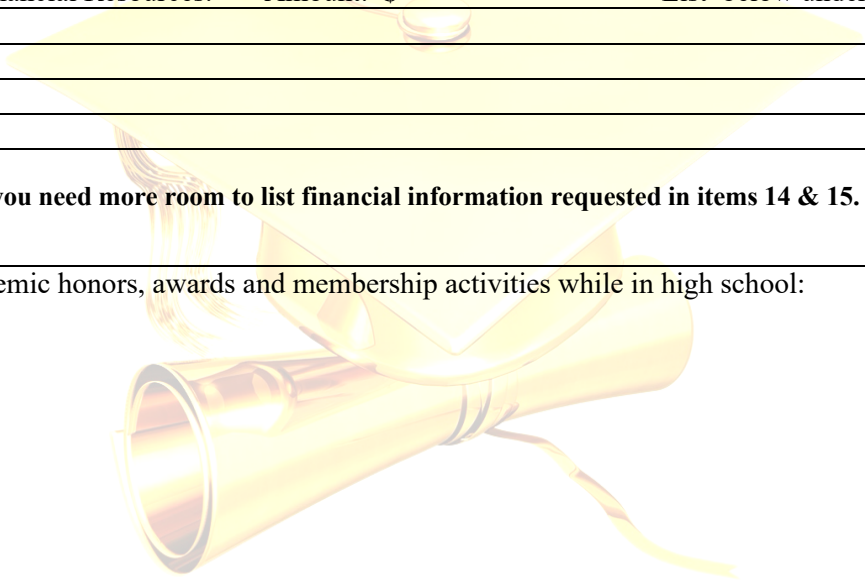
