

United Hmong Education Foundation 2023 Scholarship Fund Program Guidelines

The United Hmong Education Foundation (UHEF) is dedicated to helping Hmong youth to attend to and succeed in the educational arena. The belief that "every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources" is echoed throughout the Foundation's work. United Hmong Education Foundation facilitates partnerships with key stakeholders to increase academic achievement of youth.

The *Mission* of United Hmong Education Foundation is to BUILD a collaborative network of diverse stakeholders to IMPROVE the quality of education in the targeted communities.

The *Vision* of United Hmong Education Foundation is empowering the youth in the designated area with need-based educational resources.

The *Purpose* of the UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund and UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund is to provide scholarships to deserving high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study at either a two-year or four-year educational institution.

For 2023, the UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund's award ceiling is \$3,000. UHEF will award scholarships, ranging in amounts from \$500 - \$3,000 per award, based on applicant's college/university choice and how many applicants. NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution and class schedule submitted for fund disbursement. Scholarship funds will be distributed at the beginning of each school Semester, with 50% of funds for each disbursement.

Criteria and eligibility (UHEF Zong Cheng Hawj Scholarship Fund applicants)

- 1. Applicant must be a Hmong descent.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
- 5. Applicants may not be immediately related to any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

For the UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund, UHEF will award scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 - \$5,000 per award. For returning scholarship recipients, scholarships may be renewed if the recipient has met renewal criteria. The total number of renewals will be determined by the UHEF Scholarship Committee.

Criteria and eligibility (UHEF FUTURE Scholarship Fund applicants)

- 1. Applicant must be a Hmong descent.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 4. Applicant must have a desired college major in Science, Technology, or Engineering.
- 5. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
- 6. Applicants may not be immediately related to any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

Criteria and eligibility (returning recipients)

- 1. Applicant must be a recipient of the UHEF Scholarship Fund Program.
- 2. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year educational institution.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 4. Applicants may not be immediately related to any Board of Directors or Leadership Team.

General Instructions

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications must be postmarked by April 30, 2023, 5:00 p.m. (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
- 4. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at <u>https://www.theuhef.org</u>/.
- 5. You will be notified by mail in June regarding the status of your application.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 5. Personal Essay. Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font.

Application Renewal Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (i.e. college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of college instructors, advisors, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent college transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 5. Personal Essay. Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font. Essay shall contain no grammatical errors.

6. In addition to the above items, applicant must also complete at least 40 hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter.

Deadline for the application is April 30, 2023, 5:00 p.m. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
